

LATAM Airlines Group reports preliminary monthly statistics for April 2015

Santiago, Chile, May 8, 2015– LATAM Airlines Group S.A. and its subsidiaries, ("LATAM Airlines Group" or "the Company") (NYSE: LFL / IPSA: LAN / Bovespa: LATM33), the leading airline group in Latin America, today reported its preliminary monthly traffic statistics for April 2015 compared to April 2014.

System passenger traffic increased by 0.5% while capacity increased by 1.5%. As a result, the Company's load factor for the month decreased 0.8 points to 81.6%. International passenger traffic accounted for approximately 52% of the month's total passenger traffic.

Domestic passenger traffic in LATAM Airlines Group's Spanish speaking operations (Chile, Argentina, Peru, Ecuador and Colombia) rose 4.6%, while capacity increased by 5.2%. As a consequence, the domestic passenger load factor decreased 0.4 points to 77.4%.

Domestic passenger traffic in Brazil decreased by 1.8%, while capacity decreased by 2.7%. As a consequence, the domestic Brazil passenger load factor increased 0.8 points to 81.7%.

International passenger traffic increased by 0.7%, while capacity increased by 3.2%. Accordingly, the international passenger load factor for the month decreased 2.0 points to 82.9%. International traffic includes international operations of both LAN and TAM on regional and long haul routes.

Cargo traffic for LATAM Airlines Group decreased 11.2% as capacity decreased 0.2%. As a consequence, the cargo load factor decreased 6.7 points to 54.4%. The decrease in cargo capacity is a result of reduced freighter operation. Cargo traffic decrease was driven by a weaker cargo scenario in Latin America, mainly due to the economic slowdown in the region.

LATAM Airlines Group S.A. is the new name given to LAN Airlines S.A. as a result of its association with TAM S.A. LATAM Airlines Group S.A. now includes LAN Airlines and its affiliates in Peru, Argentina, Colombia and Ecuador, and LAN Cargo and its affiliates, as well as TAM S.A. and its subsidiaries TAM Linhas Aereas S.A., including its business units TAM Transportes Aereos del Mercosur S.A., (TAM Airlines (Paraguay)) and Multiplus S.A. This association creates one of the largest airline groups in the world in terms of network connections, providing passenger transport services to about 135 destinations in 24 countries and cargo services to about 144 destinations in 26 countries, with a fleet of 314 aircraft. In total, LATAM Airlines Group S.A. has approximately 53,000 employees and its shares are traded in Santiago, as well as on the New York Stock Exchange, in the form of ADRs, and Sao Paulo Stock Exchange, in the form of BDRs.
