

## LATAM Airlines Group reports preliminary monthly statistics for April 2018

**Santiago, Chile, May 9, 2018**– LATAM Airlines Group S.A. and its subsidiaries, ("LATAM Airlines Group" or "the Company") (NYSE: LTM / IPSA: LTM), the leading airline group in Latin America, today reported its preliminary monthly traffic statistics for April 2018 compared to April 2017.

System passenger traffic increased 0.8%, while capacity rose by 1.4%. As a result, the Company's load factor for the month fell 0.5 percentage points to 83.4%. International passenger traffic accounted for approximately 60% of the month's total passenger traffic.

The following table summarizes traffic figures for the month and includes a year-to-date breakdown for LATAM's main business units.
