

Sustainable Packaging

There is an ongoing commitment on shifting towards sustainable packaging and to progressively remove single use plastics from our flight operations and ground activities for the passenger and cargo businesses.

There is continuous work with the supplier network to identify and develop solutions for in-flight waste management. For instance, the Recycle Your Trip corporate program following a pilot stage in 2018 in Chile. The program will extend to include Colombia, Ecuador, Peru and Brazil in 2022. Also, a project to eliminate single-use plastic on board, such as plastic cups and wrapping for blankets, pillows, earphones, and flatware used for meals and other items, is also underway. This effort involves suppliers and various teams as well.

In the table below the use of different packaging materials for 2019 are presented.
